Program Dates

- Dates of Disney Program: **May 20, 2019 – August 15, 2019**

Pay Rate

- Pay rates start at \$10.00 USD/hour - minimum of 30 hours per week

Participants are responsible for:

- Sevis Fee - \$35 (approximate)
- Visa Processing Fee - \$190 (approximate)

Medical Insurance

- Students must purchase medical insurance through **Lloyd's of London** prior to traveling to the USA (more information will be provided at a later time).

Housing Costs

- \$111 to \$200 per week (depends on the type of the unit and housing complex)
- Program Participation Fee is \$375 (includes the Program Fee and prepaid Housing Fee)
 - Program Fee (\$240) - The one-time non-refundable fee helps support the administration, events and activities scheduled in the housing complexes throughout the program. Participation in one Cultural Event per month is mandatory.
 - Housing Fee (\$135) - This required non-refundable fee will be applied to the participant's housing costs during the first week of the program.
- Participants share a bedroom with one or two other participants.
- Transportation provided to and from work at no cost. Also to grocery and some other venues.
- All complexes are gated with on-site security 24/7.

Airfare

- Participants are responsible for their round-trip flights to and from the USA.

Criminal Background Check – Police Clearance Certificate

- If selected, students must provide copy of Police Certificate and other documents to our agent for certification (more information will be provided at a later time).
